

CHIROPRACTOR

Chiropractors are specialists in spinal health. They treat the body's nervous system through spinal tweaks.

To be qualified you will need to complete a three year undergraduate degree, then a compulsory masters for two years. You will also have to sit an extra exam for accreditation from the Chiropractor's Association of Australia.

You will work full time in your own practice or as an associate.

In a normal day you will work two split shifts. You will see clients and perform the required adjustments on their spine.

The hard part is you will need to be strong in order to perform some of the techniques on patients. This can force you to be fit and healthy yourself!

You will earn \$80,000 upon graduation. This will increase with industry experience to more than \$100,000.
