

OUTDOOR ACTIVITIES INSTRUCTOR

To be qualified you are required to have a Certificate III in outdoor recreation, as well as training in First Aid and qualifications in specialised activities, e.g. abseiling.

You will work for an outdoor recreation camp or for a contractor who supplies staff to camps. You could be working with schools, corporates or targeted groups, e.g. at risk youths or adults with disabilities.

In a normal day you will divide your time between outdoor activities and indoor lessons in confidence, team-building, problem solving and goal setting.

The hard part is the hours and keeping a work/life balance.

You will earn approximately \$10 to \$20 per hour.
